






FIRST® Team Roles

Training and screening requirements apply to US and Canada volunteers only (encouraged for all Global volunteers).





ROLE NAME	BRIEF ROLE DESCRIPTION	FIRST® DASHBOARD	YOUTH PROTECTION CLEARANCE	MENTOR READY TRAINING
<p><i>Lead Coaches 1 and 2 are responsible for ensuring that other volunteers working with their team are appropriately trained, screened, and meet FIRST requirements.</i></p>				
<p>Lead Coach 1 Lead Coach 2</p> 	<p>Adult volunteers that lead the day-to-day activities of the team.</p> <p>Has the authority to make leadership decisions for the team and are the primary contacts for the team.</p> <p>Each team must have two adults in this role. One is recommended to be at least 25 years old.</p> <p>Leads can create new teams, manage team contacts, edit team information, make registration payments, register team participants, and view youth information. (Note: Lead Coach 2 cannot invite Lead Coach 1 or Team Administrator.)</p> <p>All Coaches are mentors, but not all mentors are coaches – coaches have authority regarding team decisions and responsibilities.</p>	✓	✓	✓
<p>Mentors</p> 	<p>Individuals (18+) with technical or non-technical knowledge that teach and assist a team.</p> <p>Help provide valuable support and serve as a resource in their area of specialty.</p> <p>Regular relationship with the team but may not attend every meeting or event.</p> <p>This role is assigned on the <i>FIRST</i> Dashboard. It does not have administrative permissions.</p>	✓	✓	✓
<p>Youth Mentors</p> 	<p>An individual, who could be a veteran team member, serving as youth mentor to a team with younger participants. These individuals are between the ages of 13-17 years old. If you are a student on a team, you cannot also serve as a Youth Mentor on that same team.</p> <p>The utilization of this role on a team roster is OPTIONAL.</p> <p>This role is assigned on the <i>FIRST</i> Dashboard. It does not have administrative permissions.</p>	✓	✗	✗
<p>Team Volunteers</p> 	<p>Individuals (18+) who regularly volunteer with and support the team, but they are not a mentor or the coach.</p> <p>The team may be chaperoned and/or supported in another way by this individual.</p> <p>The utilization of this role on a team roster is OPTIONAL.</p> <p>Teams that have additional adult support could roster these individuals as “Team Volunteers” (ex. support logistics) or “mentors” (ex. teach/guide) whichever role is appropriate.</p> <p>This role is assigned on the <i>FIRST</i> Dashboard. It does not have administrative permissions.</p>	✓	✓	✗

Team Administrator 	<p>Individuals (18+) who do not collaborate directly with the team but can create a team, have access to financial information to procure resources for the team, can add/remove Leads Coach 1/2 (but no other rostered roles), and manage the youth roster*.</p> <p><i>Note: A Lead Coach 1 can perform all functions of a Team Administrator role and does not need to be assigned to that role in addition to being the Lead Coach 1.</i></p> <p>The utilization of this role on a team roster is OPTIONAL.</p> <p>*Team Administrators who plan to manage the youth roster are required to obtain Youth Protection Clearance.</p>	✓	✓*	✗ <i>Data Privacy for Mentors Training Required</i>

NON-ROSTERED ROLES
Many people support teams. *Here are some examples of other non-rostered roles.*

Subject Matter Experts 	<p>This individual has infrequent or inconsistent interactions with a team.</p> <p>The individual may be a temporary consultant sharing expertise. (ex. An individual indirectly assists a team with something such as fabrication.)</p> <p>The role may be held by different individuals from season to season.</p>	✗	✗	✗
Supporters 	<p>Individuals who indirectly support the team and has infrequent or inconsistent interactions with a team. (ex. individuals who are parents or guardians.)</p> <p><i>If an individual directly and consistently engages with youth they should be rostered as "Team Volunteers" and take Youth Protection Program training and undergo Youth Protection Program screening.</i></p>	✗	✗	✗
